#### **ABOUT THE BANDS**

A native of Long Beach, California, Laurie Lewis first came to prominence in the Northern California bluegrass scene, cofounding the originally all-female band, the Good Ol' Persons in the mid-1970s. Combining a deep knowledge and love of traditional music with a strong innovative streak, Laurie went on to a stellar career. As band-leader, singer, instrumentalist, and prolific song writer, she has toured throughout the U.S. and the world, including appearances at the Grand Ole' Opry and the Prairie Home Companion. Loved by her fans and respected by her peers, Laurie has been a California Woman's Fiddling Champion, was twice named Female Vocalist of the Year by the IBMA (International Bluegrass Association), and received a Grammy in 1997 for her contribution to the CD *True Life Blues: The Songs of Bill Monroe*. Of her latest CD, *Skippin' and Flyin'*, the Durham NC News- Observer wrote, "...Lewis is, gloriously, a bluegrass fiddler, songwriter, singer, and bandleader whose roots are planted firmly in soil lovingly tilled by the 'The Father of Bluegrass,' Bill Monroe."

Like Laurie Lewis, John Reischman also got his start as part of the Northern California Bluegrass scene. In fact he was also a member of the Good Ol' Persons, although he started with the band in 1978, a year after Laurie left. Another point of contact, both Laurie and John participated in the Grammy award-winning CD True Life Blues. One of the world's great mandolinists, John is especially known for the purity of tone, tasteful arrangements, and assiduous musicality. With the formation of The Jaybirds, John has proven to be a band leader who can mold the talents of great musicians with elements of bluegrass and old time string band music to create a sound that is new, refreshing, and endlessly entertaining. Of the their latest CD, Stellar Jays, Tim O'Brien writes, "John Reischman and the Jaybirds know the best new Bluegrass grows from classic roots...(the new CD) has all the elements: hard driving instrumentals, lonesome singing, and an excellent cross section of originals mixed with traditional covers."

#### ABOUT THE FORD AMPHITHEATRE

The Ford Amphitheatre is located at 2580 Cahuenga Blvd. East, Hollywood, CA 90068, just off the 101 Hollywood Freeway across from the Hollywood Bowl and south of Universal Studios. The grounds open two hours before showtime for picnicking. The Ford offers a number of dining options: a variety of food and beverages is available on site and box dinners for evening events may be ordered in advance. Patrons are welcome to bring their own food and drink. The Ford is disabled accessible. Portable wireless listening devices are available upon request. On-site, stacked parking costs \$5 per vehicle for evening shows and \$1 per vehicle for morning family shows. For evening shows only, FREE non-stacked parking serviced by a FREE shuttle to the Ford, for evening amphitheatre performances only, is available at the Universal City Metro Station lot at Lankershim Blvd. and Campo de Cahuenga. The shuttle, which cycles every 15-20 minutes, stops in the "kiss and ride" area. This event is part of the Ford Amphitheatre 2013 Season, a multi-disciplinary arts series produced by the Los Angeles County Arts Commission in cooperation with Los Angeles County based arts organizations. 

The BASC Bluegrass Jam in the Park: On the fourth Sunday of every month, pickers from far and wide gather at one of Southern California's premier bluegrass events, the BASC Bluegrass Jam. This jam is for pickers of all skills and experience. Starting in January 2013, the new location of the Jam will be the West Valley Music Center, 24424 Vanowen Street, West Hills, CA 91307.

Bluegrass Night at Viva Cantina: On the third Tuesday of every month, we provide a showcase for Southern California's best bluegrass bands (and an occasional traveling band) at this great Burbank restaurant. Admission is free and Viva Cantina serves up some of the best American and Mexican food around, and at reasonable prices.

**Bluegrass at the Ford:** Since 1997, we have brought top national bluegrass bands to Los Angeles for this annual summer concert. Past artists have included J.D. Crowe, Michael Cleveland, Laurie Lewis, the Lonesome Riverband, and IIIrd Tyme Out. This August we are presenting Laurie Lewis and the Right Hands & John Reischman and the Jaybirds.
