#### **Crazy Heart**

Crazy Heart is without a doubt the latest band to emerge from the Socal Bluegrass scene. In fact it is still emerging, working on the transition from "pick-up band" to "band" right before your eyes and ears. Its a work in progress, a little rough around the edges, but very exciting, lots of fun, and endlessly entertaining. Crazy Heart aims at providing hard driving, straightahead bluegrass in the traditional vein with an occasional foray into balladry and blues, just for contrast. Always focused on entertaining, the band tries to impart that special Bluegrass Feeling -- good ole' traditional music with a modern flair...and it has to have good beat! Crazy Heart is made up of some fine pickers and singers from the Socal bluegrass scene. Sharing lead singing duties and picking on the mandolin, Jeff Fleck has spent the last few years behind the sound board. He is thrilled to be looking at the faces of the audience now, instead of the backs of their heads. Fred Heilbrun took up guitar and banjo as a young boy and is interested in wide variety of acoustic music. He continues to be an active member of the Southern California bluegrass scene. Raised deep in the rural northwest, bassist Ron Vance wasn't exposed to the subtleties of bluegrass music until he moved to Los Angeles. His study continues. Korey Simeone has been playing violin since the age of 11 but has only dabbled in bluegrass for the last decade, having started his bluegrass education as a part of the Austin Lounge Lizards. He looks forward to learning even more about this great American genre. Finally, Johnny Wiersma, who got his early bluegrass education at the famous Signal Hill Soup Jam, completes the band with his fine lead vocals and hot guitar solos.







#### Here's what we do.

The BASC Bluegrass Jam in the Park: On the fourth Sunday of every month, pickers from far and wide gather at one of Southern California's premier bluegrass events, the BASC Bluegrass Jam. This jam is for pickers of all skills and experience. Starting in January 2013, the new location of the Jam will be the West Valley Music Center, 24424 Vanowen Street, West Hills, CA 91307.

Bluegrass Night at Viva Cantina: On the third Tuesday of every month, we provide a showcase for Southern California's best bluegrass bands (and an occasional traveling band) at this great Burbank restaurant. Admission is free and Viva Cantina serves up some of the best American and Mexican food around, and at reasonable prices.

**Bluegrass at the Ford:** Since 1997, we have brought top national bluegrass bands to Los Angeles for this annual summer concert. Past artists have included J.D. Crowe, Michael Cleveland, Laurie Lewis, the Lonesome Riverband, and IIIrd Tyme Out. This August we are presenting Laurie Lewis and the Right Hands & John Reischman and the Jaybirds.
